INSTRUCTIONS FOR SUPPORT BOAT IDENTIFICATION

Support Person Any person who

- (a) provides, or may provide, physical or advisory support to a competitor, including any coach, trainer, manager, team staff, medic, paramedic or any other person working with, treating or assisting a competitor in or preparing for the competition, or
- (b) is the parent or guardian of a competitor.

Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020

1. All support boats are required by the Notice of Race to be registered with the Organising Authority. The race office will be conducting registration between 1000 and 1600, and 1800 and 1900, on Sunday 25th and between 0900 and 1000 on Monday 27th August.
2. To complete registration support boats shall provide details of the boat, the names of the competitor(s) that the boat is supporting, and the name of the person-in-charge of the boat.
3. Support boats will be issued with self-adhesive vinyl numbers which shall be displayed on both sides of the outboard engine cover, or in an alternative visible position on both sides of the boat if it is not propelled by an outboard engine.
4. The person-in-charge shall keep a list of persons on board during racing, who will be regarded as *support persons* for RRS purposes.
5. Support boats shall comply with SI 22.
