INSTRUCTIONS FOR TALLYING OUT AND IN

1. The requirements of these instructions are specified for the safety of competitors.
2. The maximum penalty for failing to comply with these instructions will be 2 places added to a boat's finish place, except that her place shall not be worse than last place in the race. A list of boats that have infringed will be posted on the official notice board within 20 minutes of the protest time limit. This changes rule A5.

Competitors

3. The tally control point to check-out and check-in competitors will be located adjacent to the slipway.
4. Tallies comprise numbered yellow and blue wrist bands – yellow for helm, blue for crew. Numbers will be allocated to boats at registration and posted on the official notice board. Tallies shall be worn visibly, over clothing, on the right wrist by both helm and crew at all times while afloat.
5. Both helm and crew shall individually check-out before racing by personally collecting their tally from tally control.
6. Both helm and crew shall individually check-in immediately on returning to shore after racing, but no later than the protest time limit, by returning the tally personally to tally control.

Trolleys

7. Sailcloth labels marked with your tally number will be issued to each entry at registration. These labels shall be attached to your trolley and trailer for the duration of the event using plastic cable ties supplied by the organising authority.
